Welcome to the 1<sup>st</sup> annual ANYSA Fall Futbol Finale Tournament. We hope you develop your team and players well throughout the season and look forward to having more fun as you will get to play each team one more time in a tournament style setting. We will follow the rules as published on [www.angelinayouthsoccer.org](http://www.angelinayouthsoccer.org) website with the following changes listed below:

### **Under 5-6 Rec:**

- All teams in this age bracket will play their last scheduled games as usual and all players will be awarded participant ribbons

### **Under 7-8 Rec:**

- Four 7-minute quarters; substitutions only during quarter breaks and halftime

### **Under 9-10 Rec:**

- Two 15-minute halves; substitutions at own throw-in, goal kicks, and after goal scored.

### **Under 11-12 Rec:**

- Two 20-minute halves; substitutions at own throw-in, goal kicks, and after goal scored.

Schedules will be posted on the website at least two weeks before the tournament. Scores will be kept and the 10 point scoring system will be used to determine each age group champion.

- 6 points for a win
- 3 points for a tie
- 1 point for every goal, up to 3 goals
- 1 point for a shutout

10 points for a no-show forfeit, marked as a 0-3 win to the opposing team for all games played by forfeiting team

Tie breakers are as follows:

- 1 - Head to head result
- 2 - Most goals scored (6 goals max per game will be counted)
- 3 - Least goals against
- 4 - Coin toss



## **Conduct**

Any coach or player who is ejected from a game by a game official or the Tournament Director will not be allowed to participate in the next scheduled game for that team. Additional penalties may be enforced based on the seriousness of the incident. Players, coaches, and/or spectators ejected for unsporting behavior are to leave the complex and not return for the remainder of the tournament. Inappropriate behavior, serious foul play, and violent conduct will not be tolerated. Coaches are responsible for the conduct of his/her players and spectators on and off of the field and must promote sportsmanship, win or lose. The Tournament Director may remove a player, coach, and/or spectator from a game or the tournament for unacceptable conduct and/or actions that endanger the safety of others. In the course of tournament play, a player receiving a total of three yellow cards will "sit-out" the next game for their team. The Tournament Director may also remove an entire team for accumulating an unacceptable number of yellow and red cards. The Tournament Director may modify the Tournament Rules when the Tournament Director deems it in the best interests of the tournament to do so. All teams will be bound by any such change.

## **Forfeit Policy**

Teams participating in a tournament expect their opponent to be as diligent and conscientious as their own team in being on time and prepared to participate in ALL scheduled games. To minimize the occurrence of forfeited games, ANYSA has adopted these Game Forfeiture Rules

If a team forfeits a game in the tournament, the following rules apply:

1. The team receives a loss for the scheduled game, scored 0-3
2. A team forfeiting any game is still expected to play any and all subsequently scheduled games..
3. A game ended prematurely by a game official or Tournament Director due to the misconduct of a player, coach, or spectator shall be deemed a forfeit by that team for purposes of this policy.

### **Rain Out Policy**

If the tournament is unable to be played to due inclement weather, it shall be re-scheduled for the following Saturday.
